### WHITE WINE

Wine	Origin	Vintage	Selling Price
Masseo Bianco	Italy	2009/2010	£11.75

*Pale straw yellow in colour, and delicately perfumed on the nose, enhancing the backbone of apple, peach and pineapple aromas. Crisp and refreshing on the palette, with a cleansing finish.*

Nandu Sauvignon Blanc	Chile	2010	£12.95
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*Youthful, lively and fresh, this Sauvignon Blanc has herbal tropical notes on the nose, followed by a zesty citrus palate.*

Tin Roof Chardonnay	Australia	2010	£13.95
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*A soft buttery Chardonnay, with a smooth mouthful and a rich fruity finish. Whilst this wine makes an excellent companion to most types of food it is mellow enough to also be enjoyed on its own.*

Pinot Grigio San Giorgio/ Le Colline di San Giorgio	Italy	2009	£14.75
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*Pale lemon in colour with a fruit driven nose and a crisp, minerally palate.*

Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc	New Zealand	2010	£16.50
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*This vibrant yet perfectly balanced wine boasts a citrus-led palate and a long-lasting and refreshing finish, encapsulating the essence of what Marlborough does best*

Chablis Jacques Decharmes	Chilie	2006	£21.95
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*Lively and fresh with clean citrus aromas. Crisp, fruity and steely dry on the palate. The finish is long and lean.*

*Wonderfully fresh with intense aromas of violet and lychee. The palate is youthful, juicy, rich and well balanced.*

Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rosè	Italy	2009/2010	£14.25
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*This wine demonstrates just why Pinot Grigio Rosé is so popular at the moment. The elegant bouquet displays strawberry aromas in abundance and intense notes of acacia flowers. Dry, soft and well-balanced on the palate with a round and full bodied structure*

Masseo Russo	Italy	2009	£11.75
<i>Unmistakably Italian, with the 70% Sangiovese offering middleweight tannins and a fruit backbone of red cherry flavour, fleshed out with the Merlot's blackberry note. Nicely balanced acidity and ripeness.</i>			
Alto Plano Merlot	Chile	2009	£12.95
<i>On the nose rich notes of plum and blackberries lifted by Chocolate and Mocha. Silky yet structured with concentrated fruit flavours</i>			
Bacaro Pinot Noir	Italy	2009	£13.95
<i>Bright and inviting ruby red. Fermentation and maturation without oak has preserved a fresh and intense bouquet of snappy strawberry and red apple fruit. Light tannins and taught acidity on the palate.</i>			
Tin Roof Shiraz Cabernet	Australia	2009	£13.95
<i>A soft fruity red with ripe berry fruit and gentle spicy flavours in a mid weighted easy drinking style. The spicy Shiraz is lightened by the leafy Cabernet Sauvignon, and the two varieties are integrated and enriched by the judicious use of oak</i>			
Baron de Baussac, Carignan Vieilles Vignes	France	2009	£14.95
<i>An indigenous grape variety of the Languedoc, Carignan produces dark ruby red wines with plenty of body. Deep and inky red in colour, the wine is crammed with black cherry fruit.</i>			
Rioja Torre Aldea	Spain	2009	£16.95
<i>A deep, bright red cherry colour with a persistent aroma of ripe fruit and red berries. Long and lingering with great harmony and a pleasant aftertaste.</i>			
Mâcon Rouge "Les Roches Rouges", L. Jadot	France	2009	£22.50
<i>An enticing nose showing subtle hints of redcurrant and raspberry, with a fruity, well-balanced palate and a fresh finish.</i>

Prosecco Corte Alta	Italy	N/V	£17.50
<i>Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.</i>			
Prosecco Corte Alta Raboso Rosado	Italy	N/V	£17.95
<i>An elegant and intense bouquet, dry and soft and with fresh peach and red berry flavours on the palate and a round and full-bodied structure.</i>			
De Telmont Grande Réserve	France	N/V	£25.00
<i>One of the few remaining, family owned Champagne houses, De Telmont produces this excellent non-vintage in a medium bodied, soft and fruity, classically yeasty style. Fabulous value.</i>			
Perrier-Jouët Grand Brut	France	N/V	£34.95
<i>Produced in the Epernay region of Champagne, and dating back to 1811, Perrier Jouët consistently produces excellent Champagnes. The style is friendly and open, with a refreshing ripeness to the soft, apply fruit and a zesty mousse.</i>			
Veuve Clicquot	France	N/V	£39.95
<i>Veuve Clicquot ages their non-vintage for almost twice the required time, resulting in a superb marriage of freshness and power, with rich fruit and a mouth-filling mousse.</i>
